- In Tests, consider **lower-order batters who bowl**, as they contribute in multiple innings.

Pro Tip: Always balance your squad with at least one or two high-impact utility players who are involved in both innings.

3. Use Form and Matchups to Predict Smart Differentials

Why it matters: Fantasy cricket rewards those who take calculated risks. Picking an in-form differential (a player selected by fewer users) can help you break away from the pack.

How to use this on Vision11:

- Look beyond the average. Check a player's last 3–5 matches across formats and leagues.
- Analyze **head-to-head stats**. Some players always perform well against certain teams or bowlers.

- Watch for players promoted up the order or given a new role — those changes often result in fantasy gold.

Pro Tip: Keep an eye on team news just before the toss. A surprise inclusion or role change can give you an edge if you're ready to adapt your team.
